

Grant Funding Scheme

SEKOLAH PELITA HARAPAN & DORDT UNIVERSITY

Recipients

- A grant from Sekolah Pelita Harapan (SPH) is available for Dordt University alumni who are receiving a master's degree in education.
- If the bachelor's degree is not from Dordt, a student may be required to complete theology courses outlined by YPPH.
- Grant recipients with four years of teaching experience are most preferred.
- Required reciprocation is:
 - Two years teaching at SPH for educators with a minimum of two years teaching experience;
 - Four years teaching at SPH if there is 0-1 years of teaching experience.

Minimum Requirements

- Master's degree in education from Dordt University;
- Completed minimum of two out of four theology modules by YPPH as a prerequisition of the first 50% of the grant;
- Will complete the other two modules in the first academic year of teaching at SPH as a pre-requisition of the second 50% of the grant.
